ISOE was established in 1992 by the OECD/NEA to provide a forum for radiation protection professionals from utilities and regulatory authorities to share world-wide dose reduction information and operational experience to improve the optimization of worker radiological protection at nuclear power plants. Japan participated in ISOE in the year, and the Asian Technical Center (ATC) was established simultaneously. Then, Republic of Korea also participated in ISOE. Since then, the number of nuclear power plant has increased and efforts for exposure reduction have so far been continued. In the ATC activities so far, the efforts of Dr. Na and the late Mr. Mizumachi is noteworthy thing. In the presentation, events related to the ATC to date from the ATC establishment will be introduced as well as the outline and topics of ATC activity such as changes of an exposure situation and ISOE ALARA symposium.
